The Bill Charad Gallery was inaugurated at the Montreal Children's

Charad (1924-2002) wandered throughout Canada, painting this country's astounding diversity. Charad, who served in the air force in World War II, left behind an enormous body of work, including everything from still lifes to portraits and landscapes.
